This letter confirms that the University of San Francisco, School of Nursing and Health Professions has satisfied the requirements for clinical placement of nursing students by programs located in another state. The Division of Occupational and Professional Licensing, at the behest of the members of the Advisory Peer Education Committee for the Utah Board of Nursing, reviewed the program's clinical placement request pursuant to the Nurse Practice Act Rules subsection R156-31b-609. The Division has determined that the University of San Francisco, School of Nursing and Health Professions meets the established standards for out-of-state programs providing clinical experiences in Utah.
