Greenwall Faculty Scholars Program in Bioethics	The program is a career development award to enable junior faculty members to carry out innovative bioethics research, to help resolve pressing ethical issues in clinical care, biomedical research, and public policy. Each year three Greenwall Faculty Scholars are selected to receive 50 percent salary support for three years to enable them to develop their research program. Congressional Fellowship Program for Political Scientists, American Political Science Association	Gives early- to mid-career political scientists an opportunity to learn more about Congress and the legislative process through direct participation. Fellows work as full-time legislative aides in the House of Representatives or Senate. Applicants must have completed a Ph.D. in the past 15 years. Fellowships include a stipend of \$38,000 for nine months.	December
