## Performance over Time

Student performance has been consistent across the past three years the quantitative reasoning quiz has been administered. In 2017, the institutional average was $85 \%$ and in both 2018 and 2019, it was $84 \%$. From 2017 to 2019, Math \& Sciences students have scored the highest (from $87 \%$ to $89 \%$ ) and Arts \& Humanities students have scored the lowest (from $77 \%$ to $81 \%$ ).


## Meeting and Achieving Standards

Seventy five percent of graduating seniors were expected to score an $80 \%$ or higher. In general, graduating seniors who participated in the quiz have met this standard. However, Arts \& Humanities students have not met standards in the three years the quiz has been administered, School of Nursing \& Health Professions students did not meet standards in 2018, and School of Management students did not meet standards in 2019.


## Response Rate

The target response rate for each year is $20 \%$. In 2017, the overall response rate was $22 \%$, in 2018 , it was $21 \%$, and in 2019 , it was $18 \%$.
