PLO # 2 for French Major

2. Write in French using the disciplinary conventions and methodologies of literary and cultural analysis.

This outcome was assessed using research papers produced in Fall 2017 in FREN 450 French Algeria, Algerian France. Students wrote ten-page papers in French on a topic of their choice. The guidelines required analysis of primary sources (literary texts) and integration of secondary sources (primarily literary criticism) in order to write an original paper.

There were four students in the class, three of them were senior French Studies majors.

Professors Karen Bouwer and Matthew Motyka created the assessment rubric collaboratively and evaluated the papers together. Papers were evaluated for

- meeting (in-depth analysis, meaningful integration of sources into own argument),
- partially meeting (perfunctory analysis, weak integration), or
- not meeting
