



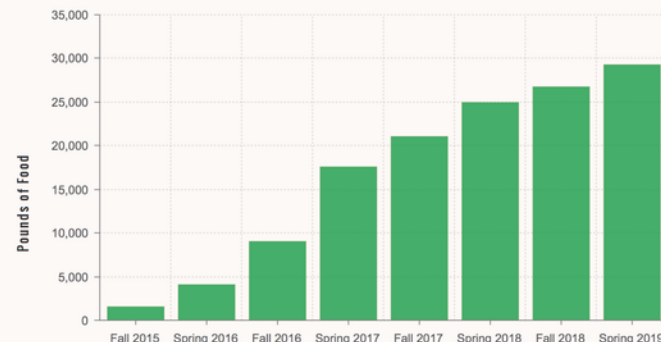

Who We Are & How We Do It

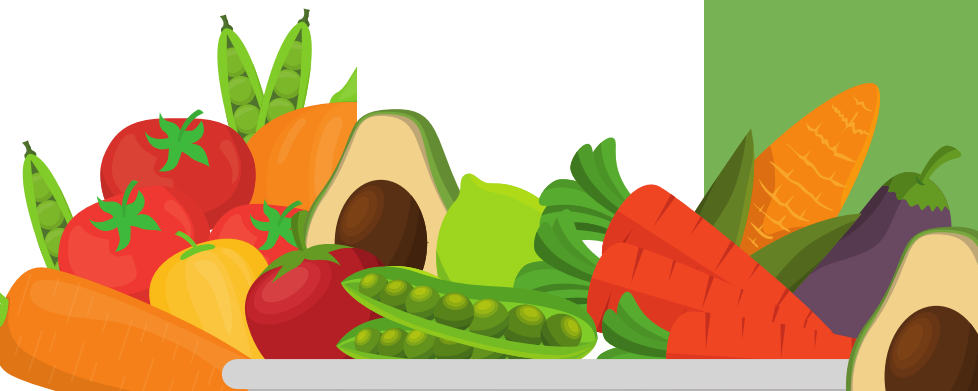
- Our chapter at USF was started during Fall 2015
- FRN volunteers have recovered between 60-150 pounds of perishable food from Market Café three nights a week.
- FRN typically feeds about 100 people at each location
- Food is typically served at the 16th and Mission Bart Station

Total Pounds of Food Recovered as of Spring 2019



FRN FACTS

-  We have recovered over **29,000 pounds of food** since our start 5 years ago
-  This is the equivalent of **12 metric tons** of carbon dioxide, the same as taking **31 cars off the road**
-  Over **29,000 meals** given out since our start
-  Through FRN, over **500 volunteer hours** are logged each week
-  Over **400 USF students** engaged



Global Food Waste Facts

 **40%** of all the food produced in the United States goes uneaten

 This is the equivalent of about **\$200 billion** on wasted food

 If food waste were a country, it would be the **3rd largest global greenhouse gas emitter**

 **1 in 4** people in San Francisco are food insecure

Bill Emerson Good Samaritan Act

- The Bill Emerson Good Samaritan Act was passed in 1996 and ensures that food donors are protected from liability so long as the food is donated to a nonprofit in good faith.
