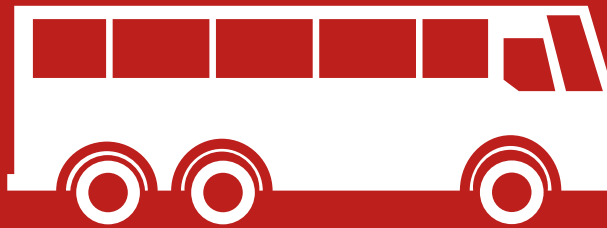




Getting Around San Francisco



Ride MUNI

Passes are free with tuition!
Save \$\$\$ on rideshares while getting anywhere in the city.

SF is committed to 100% electric buses by 2035.

Trolley buses use carbon-free Hetch Hetchy electricity via overhead wires.

Muni also has low emission electric-hybrid vehicles which run on battery power and a diesel+biodiesel blend.

Muni is the cleanest transit system of any major city in North America.

Nearby MUNI Bus Routes

5 / 5R Fulton

- Travels between Ocean Beach & Downtown
- Arrives frequently, quick way to get to destinations in Golden Gate Park

31 Balboa

- Travels between Ocean Beach & Downtown
- Makes several stops next to campus

38 / 38R Geary

- Travels between Sea Cliff & Downtown
- Arrives frequently, quick way to get around Richmond

43 Masonic

- Travels between Presidio Heights & The Excelsior
- Easy access to Target & Lucky Market near campus

- Make fewer stops & offer faster service
- Only run Monday - Friday
