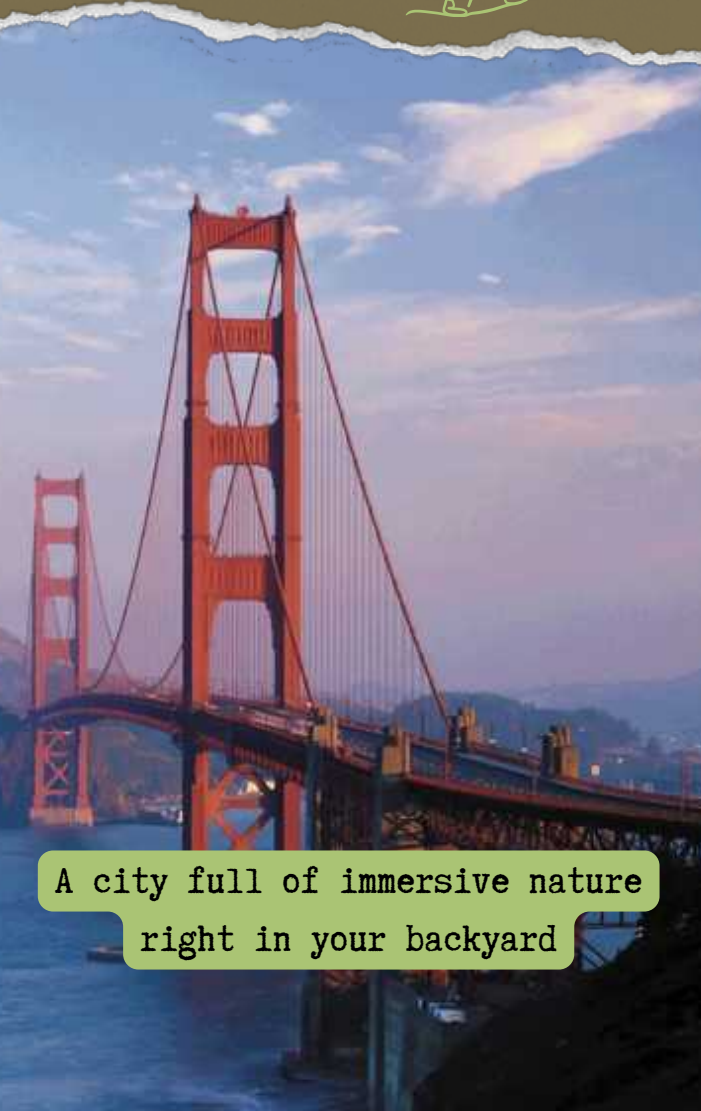


LOCAL HIKES SAN FRANCISCO



A city full of immersive nature
right in your backyard



CRISSY FIELD PROMENADE TRAIL



Rated one of the best in the city for accessibility. This hike is very flat, not gaining more than 10 feet elevation for the first 2,500 feet of the hike!

Loop length: 3.44 miles

From USF, take the 43 Muni bus for an easy ride to the trail.



LANDS END

One of the most notable hikes in the city! This hike runs along the north western coast of the city, giving you a beautiful view of the ocean and Golden Gate Bridge.

Loop length: 3.4 miles

This trail is accessible from USF by taking the 5, 31, or 38 Muni bus.



TWIN PEAKS

Twin Peaks stand as the 2nd and 3rd tallest hills in SF at 922 feet high. The views from this height are spectacular! The trail from the parking lot to the peak is paved all the way through, though there are some unpaved paths.

Hike length: 1.4 miles round trip

From USF, catch the 33 or 37 Muni bus to get to this stunning view!

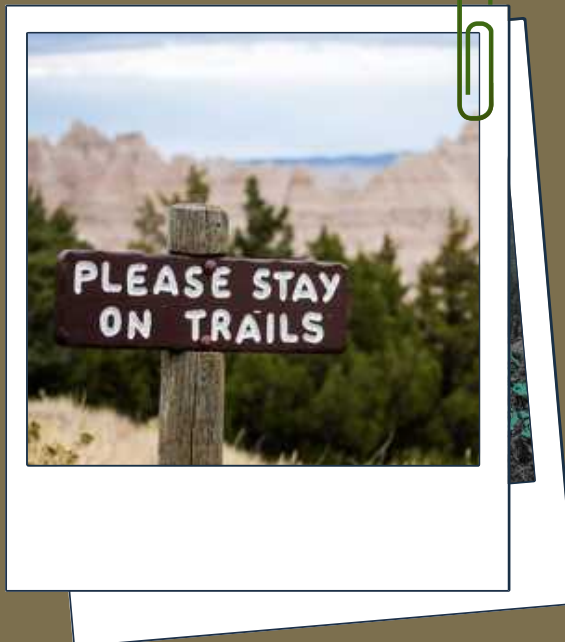


BUENA VISTA PARK

This beautiful park, located near campus on Haight Street, is small but mighty. Its hill is fairly steep, but trails are short. Hiking to the top is challenging but rewarding! Perfect for a quick, fulfilling hike.

Hike length: short, just 2 miles of paths weave through the park!

20-minute walk south of USF
