



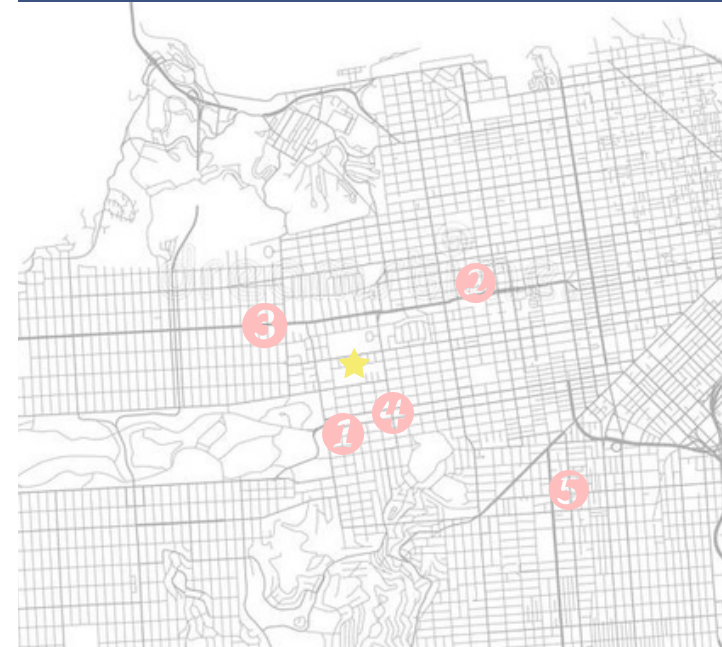
# THRIFTING IN SAN FRANCISCO

- 1) Before donating clothing or household items, make sure these items are clean and washed.
- 2) Bring donations to thrift stores or donation centers during operating hours.
- 3) Be aware of events like community clothing drives that you could donate to.

- Check items for damages
