How to Create Inclusive Assessment Materials and Remove Potential Learning Barriers:

- upload both a ppt and pdf copy of lectures
- record lectures
- ensure that figures have alt text
- provide Open Educational Resources (OER) for class in collaboration with other professors
- incorporate videos, figures, charts, etc. into lectures
- provide students with hands on activities (putting flash cards in order for example)

How to Provide Students with Variety in How They Demonstrate Their Knowledge

- on exams, have multiple choice, short answer, matching, fill in the blank
- quizzes, exams, and a written assignment

Examples of flexible attendance policies

all students are allowed 8 absences

Examples of flexible deadline policies

- students may receive an extension if they communicate ahead of time
- the lowest they can receive on a late quiz is 50%

Examples of how you assist students with anxiety and/or shyness that don't participate during class discussions

• use a polling software so students do not need to raise their hands if they don't want to

Examples of how to assist students that lack the fundamental principles that they are expected to know upon entering course

- on the first day of class, demonstrate how to approach a college class session
- offer tutorials, in which students can practice what has been covered
- post a practice quiz/exam for the first exam, going over some of the foundations
- In general, try to not assume students know a large amount of material

Examples of how to assist students that have difficulty making and sustaining progress on longer-term projects and/or multi-part tasks

• use scaffolding and bring back what students have learned
