    - Difference between Ug and Grad AoL
       — At graduate level, assessment is housed in each program. At the undergraduate level departments intersect.
    - Programs are charged with updating their curriculum maps.
    - We have had a maturation of the AoL process with regards to faculty engagement
    - Less data should be collected
    - More should be done with the data we collect
    - Committee and AoL process should concentrate on major issues rather than course recommendations
    - BSBA AoL needs to be examined in light of new BUS 100 requirement and new BUS 403 capstone course.
    - From the process to date we have learned that we need to address pedagogy and learning environment.
