Criteria: Students will be selected for a one-year scholarship based on the following:

- A. Completion of one year of J.D. study at USF School of Law by the end of Spring 2023, and enrollment at the School of Law during 2023-24. Note: Dual degree students must apply during the Spring of JD enrollment year; award will be deferred if enrollment in the subsequent year is primarily in a non-law program.
- B. Demonstrated academic potential, i.e. the student is in good standing upon conclusion of Spring 2023.
- C. Confirmed financial need for 2023-24 by the law school's financial aid process. **See Instruction #3 below.**
- D. Demonstrated detail of individual, active involvement in Maritime Law.

Please Note:

- Recipients of University funding, (i.e., scholarships, grants, stipends, tuition remission, etc.) will not be granted institutional funding in excess of tuition.

Award: One \$2000 award for a continuing student with a demonstrated interest in maritime law.

- Award is applied in equal amounts (one-half) to the student's tuition charges in the Fall and Spring semesters.
- Recipients must be enrolled in law school for both semesters to receive the full award amount.

Instructions: Along with this completed form, applicants must submit the following:

1. A brief statement, no more than two pages (double-spaced), which addresses the following:
 - a. Your demonstrated interest in maritime law.
 - b. Your plans upon completion of your law degree.
2. Current resume.
3. Submit your official FAFSA form for 2023-24 to the Federal Processor by the scholarship deadline.
Please Note: If you are ineligible for FAFSA, the School of Law Financial Aid Office will provide an alternative means of satisfying the financial need requirement.
