ISSS Office Updates

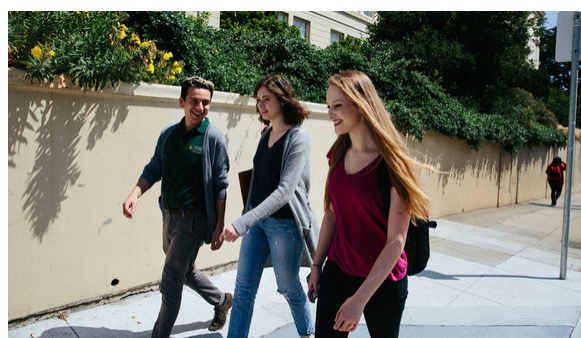
