
COVID-19 Immigration-Related FAQ

As the COVID-19 situation continues to evolve, it's important to stay up-to-date on immigration information related to your international student status. IMMIGRATION INFORMATION AND DEADLINES

Stimulus Checks and Tax Information

Some international students who filed their 2018 tax return as a resident alien received the government stimulus check last week. According to the **IRS FAQ** regarding who is eligible for the stimulus checks, it does include anyone who filed as a resident for tax purposes and has a social security number that is valid for employment. If you believe you received this payment in error, you should go through the process to return the payment.
