On Campus Housing

Student Housing and Residential Education (SHaRE) is now accepting housing applications for current undergraduate and graduate students who want to live on-campus during the 2021-2022 academic year. In order to be eligible for the housing lottery, students must apply by **Monday, March 1 at 11:59 p.m. PST**. Students who apply after the deadline will be automatically added to the housing waitlist.
