USF has nearly 300 Chinese international undergraduate students and we have heard from many of you about the challenges of managing your classes remotely. Your academic success and student experience are our top priorities, and we are eager to support you in making progress towards your degree. As a result, we will offer our USF in Shanghai program again this fall. The USF in Shanghai program is a unique program for Dons living in China to have an online and in-person college experience. More than 100 USF students participated this semester, and many have shared how grateful they are for this opportunity. Students have enjoyed both the in-person classes at Fudan and being connected to other USF students, faculty, and staff at the same time.

- **Program Description:** USF has partnered with The Education Abroad Network (TEAN) to offer a customized USF in Shanghai program based at Fudan University for the fall term. USF students will take courses taught at Fudan by Fudan University faculty and courses online and remotely from USF’s fall course offerings.
- **Program Goals:** The goals of this program are to help you stay on track this fall, gain a cohort of peers and connection to USF, study alongside other USF international students, and take classes on a university campus in China with on-campus study space and access to campus internet.
- **Application Process:** Spaces for the USF in Shanghai program are limited. The deadline to apply is May 10, and we encourage you to apply as early as possible. Priority will be given to students who are currently outside of the United States and are not able to enter due to entry restrictions and visa challenges.
- **Information Sessions:** If you are interested in learning more, please attend an information session about the program. Staff will be available to answer any questions you may have. The information session will be offered twice. Please click on the date below you wish to attend to register for the event.
