# **Employment Options for F-1 Students**

At the beginning of each semester, students are often curious about employment options available to them. Brief explanations are provided below along with links to our website where you can **find information** on employment for F-1 students and how to obtain work authorization. Please note that all F-1 students must first receive approval before beginning off-campus employment in the U.S. F-1 students should know the following about their options for employment:

- On-campus employment: All F-1 degree-seeking students may work on campus up to 20 hours per week while classes are in session. Eligible F-1 students should follow the steps listed on our webpage when seeking on-campus employment. Learn more »
- Curricular Practical Training (CPT): If you're interested in pursuing an internship or job, consider applying for Curricular Practical Training (CPT). CPT is off-campus employment, internship, or other training that is a required or an integral part of a degree program. Students may refer to the USF catalog or contact their academic department to determine whether practical training is a required or optional component of their degree program. Learn more »
- Optional Practical Training (OPT): Optional Practical Training (OPT) is an offcampus work benefit for F-1 visa holders. Students have the option to apply for 12 months of work authorization during or after their studies. Students are required to complete a workshop before submitting an OPT application to ISSS. **J-1 students:** Please note that J-1 students should check with their ISSS advisor or visa sponsor to determine their employment eligibility. Eligible J-1 students have two options to engage in employment: On-campus Employment and Academic Training. **Learn more »**

### **Requesting a document from ISSS?**

If you are requesting an immigration document or letter from our office, remember that we request **ten business days** to process requests. Make sure you plan accordingly so you have enough time to receive your document before you need it. All ISSS requests should be submitted through the **MyISSS student portal** (select the home icon, site home, and then requests on the left-hand menu). You can view our **MyISSS Student Handbook** for assistance with your submission.

### **Adviser Appointments and Workshops**

**Appointments can be made online**. Please visit the **ISSS website** to schedule an appointment. Appointments are still booked in 15-minute increments. To schedule a workshop, select workshops from the first menu option in our scheduler. Students must complete an OPT workshop before applying for OPT.
