It's important to be aware that as a nonresident student in the U.S., you are

Filing Taxes

legally required to file a tax return if you received U.S. income during 2022 (Jan. 1, 2022 - Dec. 31, 2022). Even if you didn't work or receive income in the U.S. in 2022, you're still obliged to file a Form-8843 with the IRS. The University of San Francisco has arranged free access to Sprintax tax preparation for you. Sprintax will guide you through the tax preparation process, arrange the necessary documents, and check if you're due a tax refund or if you owe taxes.
