Queer Fashion Show

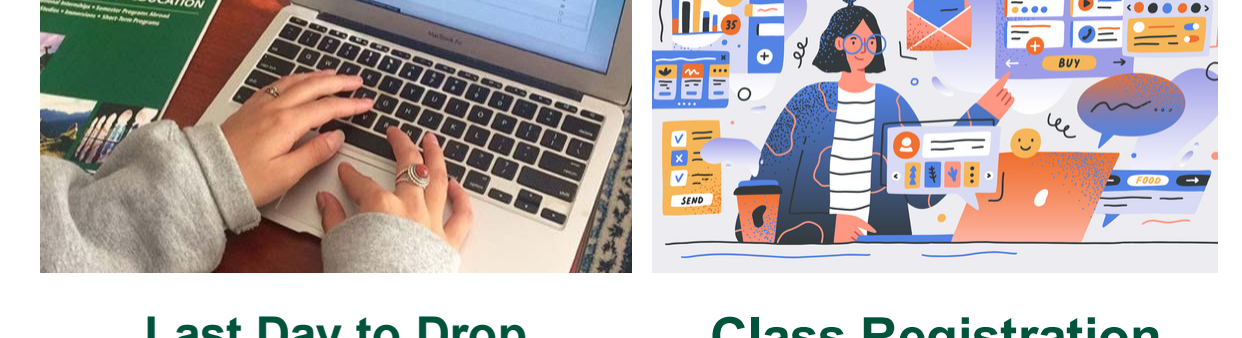

Last Day to Drop Courses or Withdraw

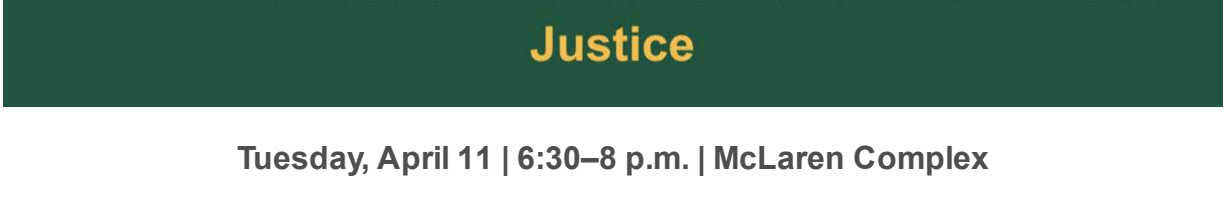
The last day for students to drop or withdraw is today, Monday, April 10. **View the academic calendar »**
