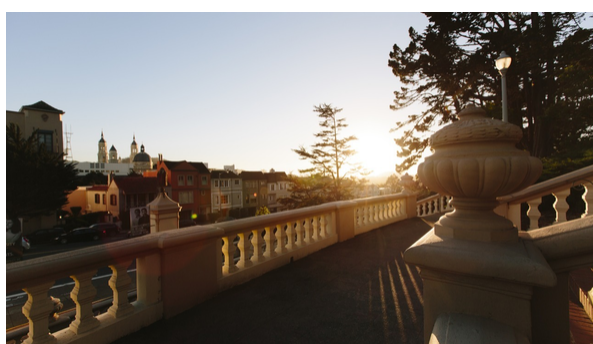


WEEKLY UPDATE – May 2

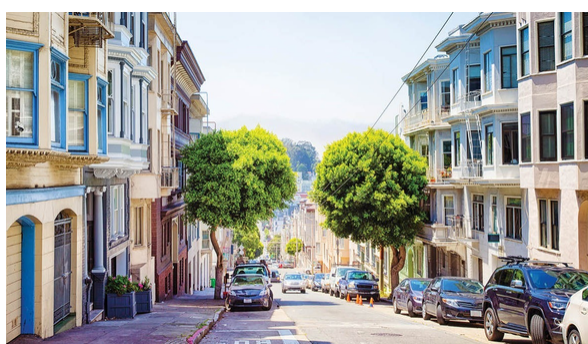
Ramadan Mubarak

Program End Dates

All F-1 students are responsible to complete their program on time. Remember that failure to complete your studies at USF before your I-20 program end date is considered a violation of your F-1 student status. Please note that the program end date listed on your I-20 also signifies the end of any student employment positions on campus. If you will not be able to complete your degree requirements by the program end date on your I-20, please **make an appointment with your ISSS advisor** to discuss your eligibility for an extension of your stay in the U.S. If you are eligible for an extension of your program, your request must be submitted at least ten business days prior to your I-20 program end date. **View additional information »**



Address Reporting

Students on OPT are required to report any changes in "Local Residence" address type (the address in the United States where you are currently living) and "Permanent Residence" address type (the address that is outside of the United States). By logging into the SEVP Portal, students are able to update these addresses in their profile information. If you'd like to update your address for other USF offices, students can go into their **myUSF** account. Note the address information in myUSF will not appear in SEVIS or be used by the ISSS office. **View additional information here under the "Updating your Address in MyISSS" tab »**
