


TAKE A TOUR

TAKE A TOUR

1. LONE MOUNTAIN

Study in the Del Santo Reading Room or watch a performance in the Studio Theater. Need to talk to admission, financial aid, or the study abroad team? You're in the right place. Head through the ground floor to grab a snack and see the city skyline from our new hillside cafe, Koret Lodge.

2. LONE MOUNTAIN STAIRS

Atop the 142 steps, you'll get rewarding views of downtown SF and the Pacific Ocean, plus local artist Yoko Kubrick's "Tides" sculpture.

3. GLEESON LIBRARY

Bask in the sunny atrium and explore student-curated exhibits in the Thatcher Gallery. Wander the stacks to find the Rare Book Room, or meet your tutor at the Learning, Writing, and Speaking Centers.

4. FROMM HALL

Creativity flows freely in the XARTS art and architecture studios. Fromm is also home to our all-female residence hall.

5. KORET HEALTH AND RECREATION CENTER

Get your blood pumping on four floors of cardio and weights equipment, basketball courts, fitness studios, and the largest indoor pool in San Francisco.

6. ST. IGNATIUS CHURCH

All Dons begin and end their journey in St. Ignatius Church, the setting for both convocation and commencement.

7. KALMANOVITZ HALL

Step through the Romanesque portal in K-Hall for your College of Arts & Sciences classes. Study or relax outside on the rooftop sculpture terrace or in the amphitheater with a 16th century portal from a Spanish monastery.

8. COWELL HALL

Future nurses in the School of Nursing and Health Professions practice patient-centered care in the Skills Lab. Broadcasting live from Cowell Hall is our student-run radio station, KUSF.

9. LO SCHIAVO CENTER FOR SCIENCE AND INNOVATION

Get your hands on the latest professional-grade equipment and advanced instruments in these light-filled labs. After class, relax in the cozy lounge or outside on the sunny living roof of this LEED Gold-certified building.

10. HARNEY SCIENCE CENTER

Code, gather data, or study human cells in our new biotech lab. While you're here, sneak a peek at the Innovation Hive under construction. It'll be open to all students and perfect for engineering majors to design, build, and print their own creations.

11. UNIVERSITY CENTER

Five floors of student services and home to many student organizations. Plan your semester with your academic success coach or meet one-on-one with a counselor in the Career Services Center. On your way out, pick up a hoodie at the bookstore and grab food from the Market Café.

12. MALLOY HALL

In between your School of Management classes, get some fresh air and mingle with future business partners in Tarantino Plaza. There's no better place to be an Entrepreneurship & Innovation major.

13. MCLAREN CONFERENCE CENTER

Come to McLaren for special events, including the annual Job Fest Career & Internship Festival featuring Bay Area companies. Bring your resume and a firm handshake!

14. UNIVERSITY MINISTRY

Find serenity in the Meditation Room and learn about immersion trips and interfaith programs for students of all (or no) faith traditions.

15. GILLSON AND HAYES-HEALY RESIDENCE HALLS

These are two of the seven on-campus residence halls (some have views of the Golden Gate Bridge!). USF offers gender-inclusive housing and living-learning communities.

16. BENEDETTI DIAMOND

Catch a game from the wraparound spectator deck, field-level press box, or VIP viewing area.

17. WAR MEMORIAL GYM AT THE SOBRATO CENTER

Cheer on the Dons at a basketball or volleyball game or attend a concert or special event. Steve Wozniak, Magic Johnson, and Anderson .Paak have all graced this stage.

18. LONE MOUNTAIN EAST RESIDENCE HALL

Play bocce ball or gather by the fire pit in our brand new residence hall, featuring spacious apartments (with full kitchens!) for 600 students, villa-style outdoor courtyards, and aerial walkways in between buildings.

19. SCHOOL OF EDUCATION*

Earn your teaching credential and get classroom experience at diverse schools throughout San Francisco. Near the parking lot, look for the USF Community Garden and greenhouse, which are open to all students interested in sustainable agriculture.

20. 281 MASONIC BUILDING*

All Dons take at least one community-engaged learning course. They're supported by the Leo T. McCarthy Center for Public Service and the Common Good, which is housed here.

21. SCHOOL OF LAW*

Just across the street are Kendrick Hall and the Dorraine Zief Law Library, where hundreds of students are preparing to earn their law degree.
