Q and A:

- What is the route a student should take to start a new organization on campus?
 - a. The UC 4 front desk has student organization consultants that can assist with creating constitutions and will help students walk through that process.
- What are the benefits of being a recognized organization by SLE?
 - a. SLE recognition provides assistance with the graphics center, the establishment of a financial account, access to room reservations through the reservation website, and visibility at events like involvement fairs.
- Can SLE assist with promotion like the Phoenix?
 - a. SLE can promote materials on the Phoenix, post on the bulletin boards, and use the TVs throughout the UC.
- Why do faculty and staff advisors need to be full time?
 - a. The advisor can be co-advisors but at least one of the faculty members must be full time since they have knowledge of the systems within the university.
 - b. Follow up: Is there anything that Senate can do to change this rule/ infrastructure?

There are ways to consider but it hasn't been explored in the past year.

- What has SLE been doing to tackle program retention or retention of members?
 - a. There are opportunities for new students to explore and also create clubs if they don't find one that they like.

 - a. No, they were not but Erin in the Cultural Centers was involved in that process.



- How much is printing through the graphics center?
 - a. The graphics center does not print but they design the material that is printed.It costs \$10.66 for 16 posters that can be posted in the approved locations.
