Senator Pairs:

- The International Student Representative has encouraged ISA involvement and collaborated on internship initiatives specifically for international students.
- The Senior Class Representative is coordinating with the Provost, working on Title IX adjacent projects, collaborating on internship initiatives, and researching job fair restructuring to address market trends and student needs.
- The Asian American Student Representative is focused on planning inclusive campus events, collaborating with vendors, and creating space for cultural conversations.
- The Transfer Student Representative is the Vice President of the Transfer Student Alliance, working on club recognition, transfer student orientation improvements, and organizing mentorship program development.
