To ensure the health and safety of everyone, we will follow these safety protocols that are in keeping with guidelines from the San Francisco Department of Public Health:

- Each graduate will be limited to two guest tickets to the ceremony in St. Ignatius Church in order to maintain space between attendees.
- Proof of vaccination or negative COVID-19 test within the past 72 hours of Dec. 17 will be required.
- Masks must be worn at all times inside St. Ignatius Church and every other indoor space on campus.
- The Dons Health Check and COVID-19 Visitor Questionnaire are required for everyone who visits campus. Students take the **Dons Health Check**. Guests take the **COVID-19 Visitor Questionnaire**.

Please note that our plans are contingent upon public health conditions.
