

# **ASUSF Elections**

Students are elected to Freshman Class Representative for ASUSF Senate through the USF Elections for Fall 2025. Only Freshman by academic standing may run and vote for Freshman Class Representative.

## **Common Questions for Election Time**

#### WHEN do I Vote?

USF Runoff Elections take place Thursday, September 25th to Thursday, October 2nd. Voting will last until 4pm on October 2nd and results will be posted within 24 hours.

#### WHERE do I vote?

All voting will take place online. You can vote from anywhere online by going to the <u>Elections Voting page!</u>

### HOW do I vote?

Log in to the online ballot, view the questions and choices, and make your selections. Use your myUSF login info:

Username: USF email (ex. student@dons.usfca.edu)

Password: USF student ID number

NOTE: Only positions in which you are eligible to vote for will be populated on your ballot. Voter eligibility is determined by the records of the Registrar's Office.

# Am I eligible to vote?

You must be a currently enrolled student and have paid the Student Activity Fee for the semester. Undergraduate students are eligible for the ASUSF Election. A valid USF student ID number will be required to vote.

#### What is the ASUSF Senate?

The purpose of the ASUSF Senate is to act as the representative body of the Associated Students of the University of San Francisco (ASUSF). The Senate will serve the needs of the undergraduate student population by serving as a liaison between the Association and the USF administration. ASUSF also advocates for the general welfare of the Association and its university and aims to bring positive, student-led change to the general student body.

## Who makes up the Executive Board?



There shall be five executive officers that make up the Executive Board. The Executive Board shall be primarily responsible for the coordination, implementation and evaluation of all Senate activities, programs, and services.

#### SENATOR REPRESENTATIVES

There shall be up to twenty-four Senators to complete the Senate and will represent the voice of the Association. Senate members shall be responsible primarily to their respective constituent community.
