



**Commuter Student Locker Statement**  
23-24-09 Resolution

**Whereas:** a core Jesuit value of USF is *Cura Personalis* - care of the whole person, which includes the physical, emotional, and financial wellbeing of USF's students; and

**Whereas:** there exists no such place on the university's campus allocated for commuter students to have an accessible space for personal locker storage; and

**Whereas:** the ASUSF Senate has previously called for the implementation of lockers in a designated location for commuter students in the ASUSF Senate Resolution 08-09-07 and the Commuter Student Lockers Funding Proposal<sup>1</sup>; and

**Whereas:** lockers will allow commuter students to have easier access to campus while accommodating for students' needs, ensuring they have a safe space to keep their personal belongings; therefore, be it

**Resolved by the Associated Students of the University of San Francisco Senate in its role as the sole representative body of all the undergraduate students of the University of San Francisco, the following be enacted:**

**Resolved:** that the University of San Francisco establish a commuter student locker program managed by the Off-Campus Living office as a pilot program to be considered for future expansion; furthermore, be it

**Resolved:** the ASUSF reserves will cover the cost of purchasing and installing 36 commuter student lockers, with related signage and promotional resources, to launch the program; furthermore, be it

**Resolved:** that the lockers be placed on the third floor of the University Center, an easily accessible location for commuter students and a central hub of student activity, or a similarly accessible space on campus; furthermore, be it

**Resolved:** that lockers be leased every semester to commuter students free of charge with assignment of these lockers prioritized for students living further than 3 miles<sup>2</sup> from USF; furthermore, be it

**Resolved:** that the Off-Campus Living office provide a report back to ASUSF Senate regarding the usage of commuter lockers and recommendations for future development one year after the program is launched.
