INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. A minimum GPA of 2.3 is required to apply. (Exceptions may be made on a case by case basis, pending approval from Faculty Advisors. If you have concerns about your GPA, please contact the Moot Court Board)
- 2. Applications are due Saturday, April 18 by noon.
- 3. Completed Applications must contain in the following order:
 - A completed and signed application form;
 - Responses to questions 1-7 (see below);
 - A current resume;
 - A copy/screenshot of your transcript from "MyUSF"; and
 - A legal writing sample indicating the semester it was written.
- 4. Please submit an electronic copy of your application.
 - Applications should be emailed to the Moot Court Board at usfmootcourt@gmail.com.
 - The electronic copy and ALL attachments **MUST be in ONE PDF DOCUMENT.**
- 5. After submitting your application, the Moot Court Board will send you a sign-up sheet for an **interview** time. Interviews will take place via Zoom.
 - If you are applying for a **Competition Team** position, be prepared to deliver a **1 minute oral argument** during your interview. We suggest using your introduction and road map from First Year Moot Court. (Applicants for Case Counsel do NOT need to prepare an oral argument.)

IMPORTANT REMINDERS FROM THE INFORMATION PACKET:

- 1. Case Counsel Receive 1 Unit Per Semester.
- 2. Competition Team Members receive 2 Units during the semester in which they compete AND are required to take the 3-unit Appellate Advocacy class in the *Fall*.
- 3. All Case Counsel and Spring Competition Team Members are required to enroll in the Advocate of the Year Competition (1 Unit) during the Fall semester. Competition Team Members placed on a Fall semester competition team are NOT required to enroll in this internal competition.
