Recommendations from UBAC to the President's Cabinet concerning fiscal year 2022 salary reduction programs, previously planned employee compensation increases, and austerity measures:

The UBAC recommends:

- The <u>current salary reduction program</u> be continued for fiscal year 2022, but with two modifications: change the reduction for the \$70,000 to \$100,000 compensation tier to 0% and change the reduction for the \$100,000 to \$130,000 compensation tier to 0%. The overall cap in reduction for USFFA members would continue to be 10% and for non-represented employees would continue to be 15%.
- Effective fiscal year 2022, and related to the previous item, move members of the university's Leadership Team to the same salary reduction program as non-represented employees.
- For the fiscal year 2022 operating plan, the President, his Cabinet, and the Board of Trustees provide the operating fund with support from liquidation of the quasiendowment of at least \$2 million.
- The university continue with a hiring freeze except for any position deemed essential to continuity of USF's critical services.
- Postponement of all new, non-donor-funded, non-essential capital projects.

UBAC understands the listed items constitute recommendations to the President and his Cabinet and the collective bargaining units have a separate role to play in conversations related to various of these recommendations.
