


# Sign in to View Restricted Zoom Cloud Recordings


For recordings that are restricted and require signing in to view, here are the steps for signing in. If you are already signed into the myUSF website with your USF username and password you will already be authenticated and will be able to access the recording or the passcode field if required. If you are not signed in yet, here are the steps:

1. Click on the link for the recording to bring up the sign in page; click on the button for SSO.




