To obtain approval, students must submit this form to the Associate Dean for Academic Affairs, accompanied by a petition identifying the school at which the student desires to visit, the student's proposed course of study, the unit value of the course of study, the dates of the visit, the student's reason for seeking approval, and any other information the dean deems necessary or appropriate. No student will be permitted to visit away unless they are in good academic standing, and the student's academic record will be considered in making the decision.

1.	The institution attended must be approved and accredited by the American Bar Association;						
2.	No USF required courses or the Upper Level Research &Writing Requirement may be taken at another institution;						
3.	Credits earned during the visit will be accepted only if the earned in letter-graded "classroom" courses in which the student receives a letter grade of "C" or better. (Clinical programs, judicial externships, directed research, independent study and the like, are not classroom courses.)						
4.	Only the credit earned for a course taken at another institution will transfer. The actual grade received will not be reflected on the USF transcript, which will report only the course title and either "credit" or "no credit" for the course						
5.	The courses taken at another institution must not substantially duplicate any theretofore or thereafter taken for credit at USI						lit at USF;
6.	The visiting student is responsible for making their own arran	ngements, includ	cluding financial, with the other institutions;				
7.	t is the student's responsibility to insure that transcripts of grades are promptly submitted to the Law Registrar in a timely ashion. Students visiting away during their last semester must ensure that official transcripts are submitted to the Law Records Office as soon as possible to ensure that the JD degree is posted in time to certify the student for the bar exam
